It has been encouraging to see the Beyond Ourselves Project developing as the weeks have gone by, with attendance remaining good and people sharing how they have been helped.

On the back of this, I wonder how you would feel about keeping the groups together to go through a kind of Beyond Ourselves 2 called 'The New Community,' (of course, others may join who have not done Beyond Ourselves.)

'The New Community' is a similar style to Beyond Ourselves but focuses on what happens when Christians come together. It looks at the community dimension of the Christian faith and what it means to worship God.

The contents of 'The New Community' are:

- Week 1 - Baptism - joining the community
- Week 2 - Honouring the presence of God
- Week 3 - The place of praise
- Week 4 - Communion, looking back and looking forward
- Week 5 - Learning to pray together

- Week 6 - More about prayer
- Week 7 - Expressing our love for God
- Week 8 - The power of words
- Week 9 - A community of love
- Week 10—Deepening our love

'The New Community' will start week beginning the 26th February 2017 with the same group arrangements breaking for a couple of weeks for Easter and then going through to the end of May just before Pentecost. Roger Morgan (the author of 'The New Community') will be preaching on Sunday 5th March.

Like the Beyond Ourselves Project, the value of 'The New Community' is enhanced by a determination to attend as many sessions as possible. There is a member's handbook which contains a weekly memory verse and exercises which reinforce the teaching of each session.
